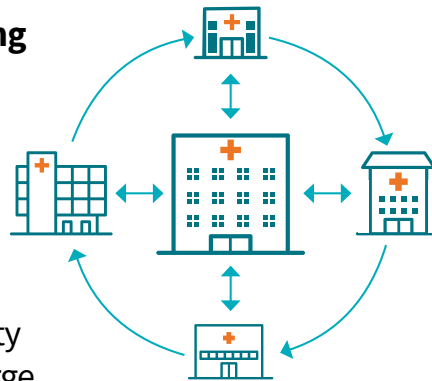

Through technology-enabled collaborative learning, **ECHO MS** creates access to high-quality specialty care in local communities.

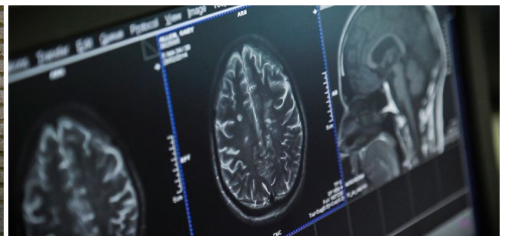
